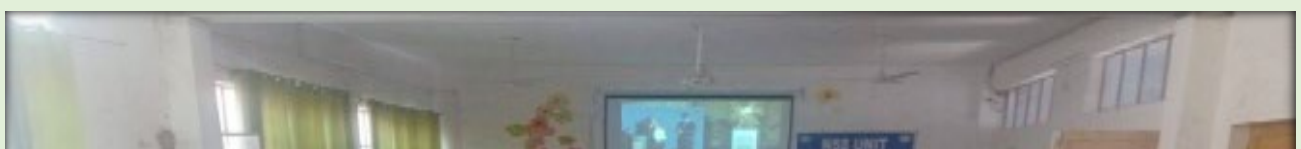
CLEANLINESS DRIVE

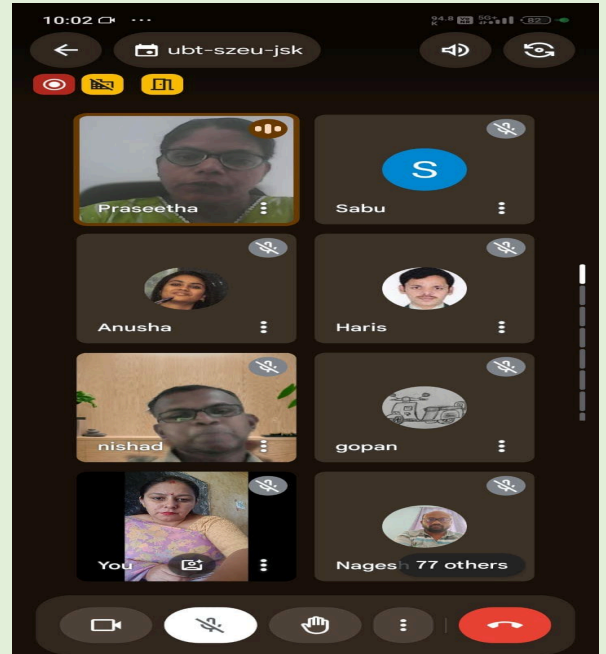
